EXPORTING LEAGUE STATS

As a friendly reminder, when exporting stats in any directory or to any floppy disk, ALWAYS use the LEAGUE MODE. Failure to use the league mode will result in incorrect team and expanded stats being transferred. Again, this error has plagued both SPB leagues in their current seasons and the situation is very difficult to correct. Again, only use the league mode when exporting stats. Jim: here are the two resolutions for both SPB I and II. I sincerely feel that we have to get a handle on both items ASAP and that this be a collective decision. Thanks for the attention to these ideas:

1- That a firm date be established for completing games and providing home report information to the league statistician so that sufficient time is allotted to allow for receipt of monthly statistics before sending out profiles for the next month. The proposal is that stats be delivered to the statistician by the 22nd of the month so that they might be returned by the last day of the month. The manager profiles/ instructions should be received by the opposing manager by the 5th of the month. The second league could have the timeframes the same, but either moved up or back to allow time, ie, the 25th, 2nd, 9th.

That will allow two weeks to play games.

2- That the use of the computer manager be made MANDATORY and furnished via disk to the opposing manager. In return, all game files, box scores, stats, be returned on the same disk to facilitate transfer.
