**MAKING SENSE OF THE TRANSFER PROGRAM**

For those managers unsure of how to make the transfer program work, try following these guidelines.

- 1). Make a directory on your hard drive called XFER.
- 2). Insert the data disk in drive A: or B: depending on your machine.
- 3). Run the SETUP program, making the above valid drive the active player disk.
- 4). Select the TRANSFER option from the strip menu.
- 5). Select the EXPORT option from the strip menu.
- 6). Fill in the EXPORT OPTION SCREENg as follows:  
Transfer file drive: [c:]  
Transfer file directory: [XFER]  
Export Statistics: Yes  
Export Manager Profile : No  
Export Scope: Team
- 7). Select team(s) to Export, beginning with your team. As the stats are being exported you should see a message on your screen acknowledging such.
- 8). Repeat Step #7 for the opposing team(s) that you have played during the series.
- 9). Next, once again run the SETUP program, making the directory where you play your SPB games the active player disk.
- 10). Select the IMPORT option from the strip menu.

11). Fill in the IMPORT OPTIONS SCREEN as follows:

Transfer file drive: [c:]

Transfer file directory: [XFER]

Import Statistics: Yes

Preview only: No

Import type: Add

Import Manager Profile: No

Import Scope: Team

12). Select team(s) to Import, starting with your team. As the stats are being imported you should see a message on your screen acknowledging such.

13). Repeat step #12 for the opposing team(s) that you have played during the series.

14). View stats through the REPORTS program.

Well, that's it in a nutshell. If you still are having problems with this portion of PTP, please call me and I'll try to walk you through it over the phone. This program really comes in handy when you want to play some series out of sequence.
