## SERIES HIGHLIGHTS

FALCONS (3) AT TITANS (3): Torgeson goes 14 for 28 with 11 runs scored. Sievers drives in 6 RBIS.

DUCKS (2) AT TITANS (4): Big Klu goes 12 for 23 w/2 "Johnsons", Mueller hits .400. Sievers hits 4 homers and picks up 9 RBI.

KNIGHTS (5) AT TITANS (1): More home runs fly out of the Polo Grounds: Berra w/5, Jones w/3, and Sievers w/5 and 10 RBI giving him 25 at home in February.

KNIGHTS (0) AT CUBS (6): Cubs bring out the broom sweeping the lowly Knights. Cubs hit an even .300 with a 2.89 team E.R.A.. Knights only manage to hit .222 for the series.

MINORS (4) AT CUBS (2): Avila goes 13 for 27 with 2 home runs and 8 RBI. Cubs win Game #1 as Reese beats a throw to the plate in the bottom of the 9th. Roberts fans 10 in Game #6.

BLACK SOX (5) AT TIGERS (1): Tiger tails are twisted as Black Sox win the last 4 games of the series. Early Wynn not only pitches a CG victory in Game #6, but homers as well.

SAXONS (3) AT TIGERS (3): Tigers blow chance for a series win by dropping the last 2 games. In game #6, Jim Hearn hurls a shutout and also slugs the Saxons only home run of the series.

FALCONS (4) AT WIND (2): Game #1 is won on a bases loaded pinch hit triple by Jim Delsing. Lopat and Maglie throw shutouts in Games #2 and #3. In Game #6, pitcher Cole clubs a 3 run homer and the game ends with Irvin, the tying run, being thrown out at the plate to end the game.

BLACK SOX (2) AT WIND (4): Game #6 sees a Black Sox triple play. Whitey Ford picks up a shutout in game #3. Game #5 turns into a great pitchers duel with Calderone doubling, going to 3rd on a wild pitch and scoring the winning run on a Musial SP.

WIND (2) AT CASCADES (4): Grissom balks home the winning run in Game #1. Cascades pound out 3 triples in game #4. In game #6, Ridzik loses it in the 9th walking Irvin and then allowing Mr. Musial to homer for the victory.

TIGERS (3) AT CASCADES (3): Trucks throws a shutout in game #2. Pitcher Branca, better known for allowing home runs, breaks a 2-2 tie with his own homer sparking a Tiger win.

CUBS (1) AT CASCADES (5): A total of 24 home runs were hit in this series. Cubs with 16 and Cascades with 8! Yet the Cascades win 5 of 6. Was it the pitching? Game #6 sees the Cubs hit 7 homers only to lose what Manager Ross calls the wildest game of the year for the Cascades, a 10 inning classic.

TIGERS (1) AT MINORS (5): Minors hit 13 home runs to go along with a team E.R.A. of 2.67. Gomez picks up 2 wins allowing just 1 unearned run in 18 innings.

BLACK SOX (2) AT MINORS (4): Some one finally stops the Minors although it takes 3 extra inning games. Hodges still manages to hit 2 more homers.

BLUEBIRDS (4) AT SAXONS (2): Lopata's grand slam in 7th of game #1 winning margin. He also homers in games #5 and 12 inning of game #6.

FLYERS (3) AT SAXONS (3): Cunningham hits a pinch hit homer to win game #1. Snider homers in the 9th of game #5 to win a 15-14 slugfest.

DUCKS (2) AT SAXONS (4): Ducks pouros defense hurts as they commit 9 errors in the series. Jim Fanning sees action after both House and Seminick are injured.

BLUE SOX (3) AT KNIGHTS (3): Knights plate 10 runs in the 1st inning of game #4. Berra hits .429 w/ 2 homers. Post knocks in 8 Knights.

MINORS (4) AT KNIGHTS (2): Minoso checks in with a .630 BA while teammate Avila hits a cool .414. Roberts picks up 2 wins with a 1.59 E.R.A..

DUCKS (2) AT BLUEBIRDS (4): Klu hits a grand slam in game #2 to lead the Ducks to a victory. Garver throws a 5 hit shutout in game #3.

CASCADES (1) AT BLUEBIRDS (5): In game #1, Boone, Vernon, and Hofman all homer for Bluebirds. Garver pitches his 2nd straight shutout, this time a 4 hitter in game #3. Bluebirds pound out 15 hits and 21 hits in final 2 games of the series.

FLYERS (5) AT BLUE SOX (1): Skowron smashes Blue Sox going 11 for 26 with a double, 3 triples, 2 homers and 9 runs scored. piersall hits .429, Banks .370, and Snider whacks the tomatoe for a .292 average with 2 homers and 7 RBI.

CASCADES (3) AT BLUE SOX (3): Rosen continues his torrid hitting, going 11 for 25 (.440) with 4 home runs and 8 RBI. The Cascades pull off a triple play in game #4. Schoendienst goes 10 for 25 (.400).

SAXONS (3) AT BLUE SOX (3): Although the Saxons only bat .214 for the series, they rely on clutch performances by House (8 for 19), Bruton (3 steals), and Tuttle (4 RBI). Hoeft's 1.13 ERA in 8 innings and Spahn's heroic 11 inning complete game performance give Schaumburg a well earned series split. Jensen (subject of many trade rumors) explodes for 4 homers and 9 RBI.

MINORS (3) AT DUCKS (3): Hodges cracks 2 homers in game #2. Simmons stops the Minors with a game #6 shutout. Big Klu wins game #3 with a 10th inning homer.

WIND (3) AT DUCKS (3): Kell drives in 4 in game #5.

CUBS (3) AT FALCONS (3): Cubs slam 8 homers in series. Garcia has a 0.96 E.R.A. in two appearances. Falcons can only hit .242 off Cubs hurlers.

BLUE SOX (3) AT FALCONS (3): Williams homers in each of first four games. Mossi blows another lead in game 6 to help the Blue Sox to a series split.

BLUEBIRDS 93) AT FALCONS (3): Boone hits .414 driving in 13 runs. Sullivan wins both of his starts.
