

SPB 1955 SEPTEMBER SERIES RESULTS

TITANS (2) at WIND (3): Whitey Ford twirls 3-hit shutout in game 2. Game 5 big flies by Randy Jackson, and Carl Furillo cap off Wind series victory.

FLYERS (3) at WIND (2): Jimmy Piersall strokes a cool .333 with 2HR and 10RBI, including 7 alone in game 5, turning Wind into a weak breeze.

FALCONS (1) at BLUE SOX (4): Sox pitching stifles Falcon sticks with a 1.20 ERA for the series. Teddy ballgame smacks two circuit blows in game one.

BLUEBIRDS (1) at BLUE SOX (4): Sox waxes Birds 21-7 in game two. Snider 4-6, trpl, 2HR, and 7RBI. Heartland pitching taking a beating on road in Sep.

KNIGHTS (3) at DUCKS (2): Knights take last three after letting down guard in first two. Bob Speake and Joe Adcock go deep twice each at cavernous Griffith Park.

TIGERS (4) at DUCKS (1): Frankfort came well-armed, led by Antonelli's 3-hitter, and Jack Meyer's 2 saves. Tigers hit only 1HR in series.

FLYERS (2) at CUBS (3): Bob Turley the walkmeister wins both Flyer games. Cubs' Bill Virdon strokes .524 (11-21).

BLACK SOX (3) at CUBS (2): Early Wynn tosses 4-hitter in game 5, and hits as many Home Runs (2), as entire Cubs team hits for the series.

BLUE SOX (5) at TITANS (0): Titans manage just 1HR & .182 AVG in sweep. Blue Sox team 1.20 ERA for series.

SAXONS (4) at TITANS (1): Pitching rules in Polo Grounds w/2.45 team ERA for Saxons. Yost 7-17, Smith 9-18.

DUCKS (2) at FALCONS (3): 7 runs minimum winning score. Rip Coleman CG 5-hitter gm4.

CASCADES (4) at FALCONS (1): Falcons only win in game 1 with a 2-hitter by Max Surkont.

CUBS (2) at KNIGHTS (3): Post hits 3 back back back back, including 7 ribeye steaks. Haddix and Minner both 2-0 at home for the month.

WIND (2) at KNIGHTS (3): Post takes 4 more with the wind, with 10RBI, including bottom of 10th game winning Home Run in game 5.

MINORS (2) at FLYERS (3): Dayton outhits Mountain Park .206-.184. Flyers win 18 inning marathon in game 2, 4-3.

BLUE SOX (2) at FLYERS (3): Turley and Pierce trade 2-1 complete game losses in games 1 and 5.

DUCKS (2) at BLUEBIRDS (3): Zuverink & Hurd combine for 5-hit Sh0 gm 3, B.Goodman 8-14. Birds only series win in September.

SAXONS (3) at BLUEBIRDS (2): Klu's big fly breaks up Delock's no-no with 1 out in the 7th. A.Smith 2HR gm 3. Kaline .455 8RBI.

CUBS (1) at TIGERS (4): Tigers win 3 1-run games, all in last at-bat.

CASCADES (1) at TIGERS (4): Dick Donovan's game two shutout only highlight of Pacific's road trip. Johnny Antonelli shines again with another CG.

MINORS (2) at BLACK SOX (3): Gus Bell .450 (9-20). Evanston 14-0 game one blowout sets the pace for the series.

WIND (2) at BLACK SOX (3): Gus Bell strikes again (.476). Sox use 21 players in a 6-5 13 innings win.

BLUEBIRDS (2) at MINORS (3): Heartland drops 3 of five in a rematch of the 1954 Championship series despite hitting .335 for the series.

TITANS (3) at MINORS (2): Toronto passes customs and wins series to boot. Smokey Burgess .500 2HR, Walt Dropo .350 2HR.

TIGERS (1) at SAXONS (4): Saxons hold powerful Tigers to 18 runs. Schaumburg hit ZERO doubles in the series.

FALCONS (3) at SAXONS (2): Saxons keep all hits in the park (0HR), Gurnee wins 2 10-inning games on the road.
