

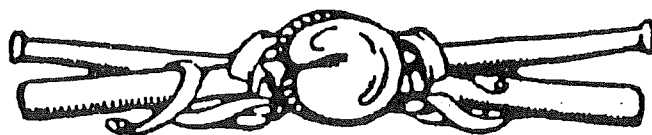

Next year, the stats should be even more in line, with the streamlined hitter limitations that will force managers to use more of their bench. But overall, the power numbers were within 5%, which is pretty good. The thing that sticks out the most, is the abnormally few number of complete games, and shutouts. Part of that can be contributed to the better hitting, knocking out pitchers earlier. But part of that is due, I think, to us managers using 90's strategy on 50's players, especially when it comes to the bullpen. Next year should bring more longevity to starting pitching.

DOES THE MANAGER MAKE THE DIFFERENCE??

Some say that the manager of a ballclub has a lot to do with the success or failure of the team, some say the manager doesn't factor in the equation as much. Whatever the argument, it is generally accepted that a ballteam plays at a certain level that is determined partly upon the difference between the runs they score, and the runs they give up. Conventional wisdom states that the team with the most runs wins. Some teams play over their heads, while some teams just go thru the motions. Some teams win big, and lose close games (most winners are in this category), while some teams win close and lose big (most losers are in this category). This section is intended simply to inform you which teams won or lost more than expected over the course of the season.

ALL-STAR SERIES RECAP

GILES OVERCOMES 3-1 DEFICIT FOR SERIES WIN

The Inaugural Seasons Past Baseball All-Star series was a memorable one, with the Giles Division winning a 7-game slugfest. The teams were picked by the league statistician based on computer accumulated statistics thru the 4-month point of the 1954 season. Not everyone was able to play, but some didn't mind. Red "Danke" Schoendienst was just happy to sit on the bench and collect his \$500.00 bonus that was stipulated in his contract.

Pitching was not spared, with a total of 81 runs scored between the two teams, along with 20 big flies. Mickey "Fireplace" Mantle, and Ted "Haven't got a" Kluszewski led the Home Run Derby with 3 apiece. Ted Williams led all batters with a .423 average. The only pitching bright spot was turned in by Warren "peace" Spahn, with his 6-hit shutout of the Giles Division in game 2.

Game 1 was highlighted by a Giles Division 16-hit attack, led by 2HR's by Duke Snider, and 4 hits by Joe Adcock. Bobby Avila (no relation to Bob Villa) also had 4 hits for the Harridges, which mounted a fierce 6-run comeback in the 8th and 9th innings, but still came up 4 runs short.

Game 2 was all Warren Spahn. A 3rd inning RBI single by Al "Guns and" Rosen, and a 2-run Homer by the big Klu was all Warren needed.

Game 3 saw the Harridges go up 2 games to one with a 2-run Johnson by Willie "baby I'm a" Mays in the top of the 9th off of Johnny "San Diego" Podres. Mickey Mantle had 5 RBI's, with Klu bopping two HR's and 4 ribeye steaks. Marv Grissom AFB collected the save.

Game 4 put the Giles Division against the wall with a 9-2 thrashing. Harvey Kuenn led the Harridge 16-hit attack with 4 hits. Carl Erskine you shall receive went 8 for the "W".

The Giles comeback started in game 5, with 7 runs in the 7th inning to put the game out of reach in the 10-4 victory. Duke Snider clubbed 5 RBI's and Mantle had 3 hits.

Game 6 saw the Giles Division jump out to a 6-2 lead thru the first 3 innings, and Bob Keegan's complete game forced a 7th game with an 11-2 flogging. Ted Williams, and Junior Gilliam each had 4 hits, in an 18-hit Giles attack.

The deciding 7th game was the only real pitcher's duel of the series between Jack Harshman, and Whitey Ford. The deciding factor was an 8th inning bases-loaded error by Al Rosen, allowing Andy "Cash and" Carey to score the winning unearned run in the Giles 3-2 victory.

Mickey Mantle was named the series MVP with 3 Home Runs and 11 RBI's.

BLUEBIRDS BEST MINORS FOR FIRST TITLE

Atlanta- The Season's Past Baseball's Championship plaque will stay in Omaha. The Heartland Bluebirds won a hard fought 7-game series against the Harridge Division winner Mountain Park Minors, owners of the league's best record during the regular season.

The Minors opened the seires on the road at Municipal Stadium by tarring and feathering the birds 12-0. Robin Roberts tossed a 2-hit shutout, carrying a no-hitter into the 8th inning, when pinch-hitter Hal Naragon laced a single with one out. Roberts walked two, and struck out three, and was supported by a 4-hit game by Irv Noren, and four team Home Runs in a 15-hit attack.

The Bluebirds pulled even in game two with an 8-3 victory. Mickey Vernon hit a 3-run homer in the bottom of the first to counter a first inning 3-run dinger by Gil Hodges of the Minors. The birds pulled away in the sixth and seventh to seal the victory. Frank Sullivan got the "W", while Ruben Gomez took the loss.

The best pitchērs duel was contested in game 3. Duane Pillette bested Ned Garver in a 3-2 Minors victory. Howie Judson survived a ninth inning Bluebird rally for the save.

The Bluebirds struck early and often in a 12-4 thrashing in game 4. Wally Westlake's only series hit was a seventh inning grand slam off of Joe Coleman. Tommy Byrne went the distance for the win, with Art Houtteman lasting only two innings for the defeat.

Game 5 was a complete opposite for Robin Roberts, as he surrendered six runs in 3 2/3 innings, as the Bluebirds won 9-4 to take a 3-2 series lead. With the Minors ahead 3-1 in the top of the fourth, Ebba St.Claire cranked a grand-slam home run, the second of the series for the Bluebirds, to put them up 6-3. The Heartland bullpen of Johnny Sain, and Hal Brown limited Mountain Park to one run on two hits over the final six innings to seal the victory.

The Minors fought back in game six to force a seventh game, with a come-from-behind 7-4 victory. Mountain Park scored three runs in the sixth to overcome a two-run defecit, and added two more in the eighth. Dean Stone relieved Ruben Gomez in the fourth for the win, and Pete Wojey hurled 1-hit ball over the last four innings for the save.

Ten Minor walks, seven in the fifth and sixth innings alone, were the deciding factor in the Bluebirds 9-7 victory over the Minors, to capture the 1954 championship. Minor pitchers walked the bases loaded twice during the fifth and sixth, with two bases-loaded walks by two different pitchers in the fifth accounting for the first two of five Bluebird runs. Frank Thomas hit a 3-run homer in the first to take a 3-1 lead, but the Minors retaliated in the second with two runs to tie up the score. The Minors built a 5-3 lead into the bottom of the fifth, when their pitchers demonstrated their extreme generosity. A wild pitch, and a passed ball allowed Mountain Park to pull to within one in the sixth, but a lead-off homerun by Richie Ashburn put the finishing touch on the win. Ashburn was also named series MVP, as he hit .381 with 10 walks, and a .581 OBP and 9 runs scored. Gil Hodges was a close second in defeat with a .296 average and four homeruns. Mickey Vernon hit 3 for the Bluebirds.
